10:00 Call to order, introductions

10:05 Update Bicycling Opportunities Map – progress towards third edition

Update Bicycling Opportunities Map Cat and Chris will meet with Bill Cook on Wednesday to review F.S. trails on map for his approval. Cat will email when final map is available to review. She will also bring map to April meeting.

10:30 Update on PBAC Co-Chairs meeting with the Mayor 2/14/08

Joint meeting of PBAC chairs Jim Knaup and Karen Warrick with Lisa Barnes from PAT. Mayor Wilson encourages cooperation between the two groups.

o Update on Sixth Street. Item has not been placed on agenda for City Council meeting to date. Probably will happen in March. Once item is on agenda, PBAC need to lobby individual council members for support.

o Update on what's happening with trails in city. Peavine connector through reservation. Forward progress is resuming—talks and negotiations. Eric Smith is working to move this forward.

o Gail Garner Way—Priority for bike lanes. Ian Mattingly will survey area residents regarding issues such as loss of on-street parking if street striped for bike lanes.

o White Spar—Lisa reported that PAT is submitting a grant request for bikeways and sidewalks.

o Citizens have initiated request for crosswalk at Gurley and summit. If council is petitioned by community group, action must be taken with 30 days.

o Grove Ave—PAT is coordinating with Prescott College to submit Grant to make Grove a model for Complete Streets in Prescott

o Planning for Bike Month has begun. This year event will run from April 15 to May 16th. Community Ride with the Mayor event will be the final activity on May 16.
