1. Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 9:31 a.m.

2. Approval of minutes

The April 3, 2008, meeting minutes were approved as written.

3. Walnut Street traffic calming request

a. Discussion

Residents from the North Walnut Street neighborhood came before the committee to request some type of traffic calming due to speeding and cut-through traffic. Because North Walnut Street is a local street, speed humps may be an option.

b. Committee action/recommendation

Once staff receives a petition from the residents, speed and cut-through studies will be conducted, with results to be discussed at a future meeting.

4. Public Input

Bob Hoskovec inquired about expediting future plans for traffic calming on Rosser Street between Campbell Avenue to Eagle Ridge. Staff indicated that a plan was designed a few years ago, and discussed at a public meeting, but residents were not interested at that time. Staff reported improvements are planned in Phase III of the Rosser Street project, which is probably about 2 to 3 years out. Mr. Hoskovec will poll the neighborhood to determine interest in the

future project. Plans could be expedited somewhat if residents are on-board.
