1. Call to order – 9:30 a.m.

However, it would probably be shelved after completion of design along with other projects due to budget constraints. The group discussed the decline in the economy and its effect of delaying most improvement projects all over the state.

4. Chairman's Report

Chairman Williams will be contacting ADOT to attempt to arrange a visit to the roundabout on Hwy 89 with a consultant to review the roundabout project and look at crash reports, as there had been several minor accidents at the location. He will attempt to have this done at ADOT's expense.
