- ▶ Original intent was to focus on creating “commotion” for the City to attract visitors
- ▶ A request is in process for the Governor to designate Prescott as “Arizona’s Centennial City”
- ▶ The Committee has adopted the theme: “Prescott: Where It All Began” with the tag “Then and Now” to be used as appropriate
- ▶ Discussion has focused on a possible “Kick-Off Event” and a total of twelve events to be held, one per month, for the period _____ to _____.

Potential Projects, events, or observances previously suggested:

- ▶ First Day Covers for State Centennial Stamp
 - ▶▶ Possible group participation – for example:
 - PUSD
 - City of Prescott
 - Special interest groups
 - ▶▶ Possible contest(s) to identify winning cover(s)
 - ▶ Publishing a Centennial Booklet to include photos and descriptive text of physical properties in the City since 1863 – for example: the Governor’s Mansion
 - ▶ PAAHC publishing a “Centennial Page” to keep members alerted to events
 - ▶ Tying in with activities which took place for the Enabling Act signed in 1910 – for example: a tree planting
 - ▶ Including and expanding on pre-planned events – for example:
 - ▶▶ Rodeo/Frontier Days
 - ▶▶ “Christmas City” events
 - ▶▶ Cowboy Poets event
 - ▶▶ Art promotion – for example: 4th Friday Art Walks?
 - ▶▶ Elks performances
 - ▶▶ Other?
 - ▶ Scheduling special meetings and conferences – for example:
 - ▶▶ Arizona Preservation Foundation meeting, 2012
 - ▶▶ State Legislative Executive And Judicial Meeting, ?
