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TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF JUNE 4, 2009, REGULAR MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:44 a.m.
2. The May 7, 2009, meeting minutes were approved as written.
3. Public Input

4. Granite Street @ Willis Street multi-way stop
 - a. Discussion – A request came in from a resident for a multi-way stop at the corner of Granite and Willis Streets. Staff reported that a study indicated that the intersection does meet volume warrants, but data needs to be reviewed for accuracy. It also met one of the traffic signal warrants, although a signal is not recommended due to close proximity to the intersection at Montezuma Street. Chairman Williams indicated that right turn movements should not necessarily be included in traffic signal approach volume, since delays are very low. Staff indicated that if right turn movements are removed then the location does not meet either the multi-way stop or signal warrants. A discussion of site distance issues caused by overgrown bushes on the corner lot, as well as parking on Granite being allowed too close to the intersection followed. It was noted however that no collisions were reported in 2008. Chairman Williams asked whether the stop bar on Granite Street could be moved closer to the corner at Willis Street, and also made a suggestion to investigate installing a westbound left turn lane. Ian indicated that he would look into it.
 - b. Committee Action/Recommendation -
Staff was directed to make changes as appropriate based on discussion.
5. Chairman Report
Chairman Williams indicated that pavement damage at Mt. Vernon is causing loop malfunctions –traveling northbound on Mt. Vernon as you approach Gurley Street, loops are cut in, but pavement is actually moving from heavy truck traffic. Tim Legler agreed to look into this and report back.
