1. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.
2. Robert Meyer made a motion to approve the August 6, 2009 meeting minutes as written. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Public Input

4. Coronado Avenue Traffic Calming Request
 - a. Discussion – Lisa Lloyd-Hanna came before the committee to request traffic calming measures on Coronado Avenue at Vista Drive. Ms. Lloyd-Hanna stated that cut-through traffic has increased due to Country Club Drive road construction, and that cars are ignoring the stop sign at Vista Drive. Due to the steep hill, there are sight distance issues when turning onto Coronado Avenue from Vista Drive. She stated that she would like speedhumps to be considered. Ian Mattingly explained that since Coronado Avenue is a minor collector, based on the Council's Traffic Calming Policy, it would not qualify for speedhumps. An exception to the policy could be requested, or Coronado Avenue (between Cochise and Anderson) could be reclassified.
 - b. Committee Action/Recommendation – Ian Mattingly agreed to approach Fire, Police and Solid Waste Departments to get their preliminary input regarding speedhumps. Ian will report findings at the next meeting.
