TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MAY 6, 2010, REGULAR MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.
2. Bob Meyer made a motion to approve the April 1, 2010 minutes as written. Motion passed 4-0 with Al Williams absent.
3. Public Input
George Sheats reported that Prescott Lakes HOA will be taking over the golf course along with some other association lands. This may result in Falcon Point resuming development activity.
4. Traffic Calming Policy Update
 - a. Discussion – Ian Mattingly met with Mark Nietupski, Public Works Director to refine the Traffic Calming Policy and add a section on threshold criteria. This draft policy has been provided to Council for review and comment by May 21, 2010. A summary of these comments will be presented to TCC, for discussion, at the June 3rd meeting.
 - b. Committee Action/Recommendation – None at this time.
5. Traffic Engineer Items:
 - a. Traffic Committee discussion – Ian indicated that changes to the committee's membership will be adopted at the May 11th, 2010 Council meeting. This includes appointment of Bob Meyer as the new Chairman and Dennis Stringer continuing as Vice-Chairman. John Tarro and Al Williams will be committee members. One additional member may be appointed to represent the bicycle community.
 - b. Traffic Control modification discussion – Ian reported that routine striping and signing requests will no longer be required to go to Council. Major traffic control changes such as multi-way stops and signal modifications will continue to be presented for Council action.
 - c. Rosser Traffic Calming - Patti Braden, Cliff Rose HOA President was invited to today's meeting, but was unable to attend. She will be present at next month's meeting to discuss possible changes to the Rosser Street Project Plans (traffic calming features).

6. Traffic Sergeant Enforcement Issues – Sgt. Fletcher asked that staff contact ADOT to report a timing malfunction with the traffic signal on Highway 69 at Prescott Lakes Parkway. There doesn't appear to be lag time between the eastbound to northbound left turn signal ending and the westbound green light for oncoming traffic. Sgt. Fletcher also reported that the use of Citizens on Patrol radar program has been effective at reducing speeds.
7. Chairman's Report – Nothing to report.
