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### TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MARCH 3, 2011, REGULAR MEETING

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.
2. Dennis Stringer made a motion to approve the February 3, 2011 minutes as written. Motion passed 4-0, with Lisa Barnes absent.
3. Public Input  
None.
4. 2010 High Traffic Collision Locations
  - a. Discussion – Ian Mattingly discussed the report and how the numbers are calculated. Intersections with highest rates were 4-Points and Gurley Street at Montezuma Street.
  - b. Committee Action/Recommendation – No action at this time.
5. Multi-way Stop Evaluation Thumb Butte & Plaza Drive Intersection
  - a. Discussion – Resident Cathy Smith brought forward a request for a 4-way stop at Thumb Butte Road and Plaza Drive. Ian Mattingly explained that Thumb Butte Road is a major collector, while Plaza Drive is a local street. 7,200 vehicles travel Thumb Butte Road each day, while 503 vehicles travel on Plaza Drive and stop at this stop sign. There were no accidents in the past six years. This intersection does not meet warrants for a 4-way stop. Realignment of the intersection and trimming of vegetation to obtain better sight distance was discussed.
  - b. Committee Action/Recommendation – Investigate improvements to sight distance, the addition of a stop bar, and realignment of the intersection.
6. Traffic Engineer Discussion Items:
  - a. Rosser Street public meeting – The public meeting will be held tonight at Taylor Hicks School. Ian Mattingly will provide residents with an update on the project and review the 3 possible options proposed. Al Williams felt that the committee should send an opinion letter to Council regarding their recommendations on the reconstruction and possible removal of traffic calming in the Meadows. A draft will be prepared and reviewed at the April TCC meeting.
  - b. Transportation Coordinating Committee Update – Ian Mattingly discussed with Laurie Hadley the frustrations the committee is having with defining their role with the current Council. It was agreed that committee representatives along with Ian Mattingly and Mark Nietupski would meet with the Mayor to discuss.
