

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CITY OF PRESCOTT

FY2012 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A PUBLIC HEARING will be held on **Tuesday, March 27, 2012 at 3:00 PM** in City Council Chambers, City Hall, 201 S. Cortez Street, Prescott, AZ 86303 and will include the following:

The One-Year Action Plan draft includes recommendations for the anticipated CDBG federal grant allocation of \$222,897.00. A Citizens Advisory Committee will advise the Prescott City Council on the use of these funds. Public comment will be taken at the public hearing.

The Citizens Advisory Committee has identified the following priority funding needs for FY 2012: Meals on Wheels emergency weekend meals for the elderly homebound and disabled; Coalition for Compassion and Justice, low- to moderate income owner-occupied housing repairs; Catholic Charities, affordable housing weatherization project; West Yavapai Guidance Clinic facility rehabilitation for low- to moderate clientele; Fair Housing, educational activities; and, general administration costs. The priority needs are subject to change prior to the plan's approval by City Council.

Copies of the plans are available for review beginning March 7, 2012 at the following City of Prescott locations: Community Development Department, Grants Administration Division, 201 S. Cortez Street, Prescott, AZ; and, the Prescott Downtown Library, 215 E. Goodwin Street, Prescott, AZ. The 30-day public review and comment period for the draft 2012 Action Plan begins March 8, 2012 and will end on April 6, 2012. Written comments regarding the Draft FY 2012 Action Plan received during the public comment period will be incorporated into the final FY 2012 Action Plan.

Members of the public, especially low- and moderate-income persons, are encouraged to attend the public hearing and comment on the draft plans.
