TO ALL BIDDERS BIDDING ON THE ABOVE PROJECT:

The following addendum shall be made part of the Contract Documents. All other provisions of the Contract Documents remain unchanged. The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum on page 14 of the Proposal by inserting the addendum number and date on the executed page of the Proposal. The contents of this Addendum shall be given full consideration in the preparation of the Bid.

CLARIFICATIONS:

RFI (1) - The specs for the LPS (Low Pressure Sewer) does not indicate size or type of pipe existing. Most of the areas that we have supplied in that area was PVC (either Sch 40 or in some areas-Sch80) pipe & glue joint fittings. Can you please comment on this item for us? (pay item 615.7a)

KWE Response - Bidders to use Sch 80 matching the pipe diameter being relocated.

RFI (2) - Will pea gravel/tree sand be acceptable as Bedding & Shading over storm drain?

KWE Response - Pea gravel/tree sand is acceptable per the Detail 2-02P.

RFI (3) - Will all the storm drain pipe be required to have a camera inspection as per the specs?

KWE Response - Yes video inspection per the specifications.

RFI (4) - What testing will be required on the new 1" water services?

KWE Response - Defer to City requirements on testing for 1" water services.

RFI (5) - Are the existing Gas, Power, And Phone conflicts being handled or do we have to coordinate that work? If so, that is quite a few relocations to have completed, prior to our storm drain work, approximately 8 gas, 12 APS, and 14 Telephone. It would appear that they will all have to be lowered to ensure proper cover and separation per COP 3-20P. This will require a significant amount of time for them to complete. How does the City envision this happening or paying us to help coordinate?

KWE Response - The dry utilities have been or are being relocated by each respective utility company. The Contractor will still be required to coordinate efforts for relocation with affected utilities discovered during construction. This work effort should be included in the unit bid price for storm pipe per lineal foot per the Bid Schedule.

RFI (6) - Are the concrete removals required for storm drain installation, included in the concrete bid tab items?

KWE Response - Yes, bid schedule concrete quantities include new replaced concrete.

RFI (7) - Are the concrete removals & landscape restoration required for water service installation to included in the bid tab items for new 1" copper service?

KWE Response - Yes, include all necessary work related to the new 1" water service in that bid item including any curb removal, replacement, and landscape restoration.

RFI (8) - Should all required demo be placed in the individual line items or somewhere else?

KWE Response - Yes, include any demolition with the related bid item.

RFI (9) - At Station 17+18, there are two water services to be removed and replaced. It appears that there is an existing catch basin, on the North side of the roadway and it appears to be on the existing water main. Does the City have any knowledge or concerns regarding this?

KWE Response - Yes, the City is aware of this situation as represented on the plans the water main is located near or under the concrete gutter. If any concrete is damaged during service installation, it must be repaired at the Contractor's expense.

RFI (10) - There is not any asphalt patching called out on Darby Creek Way to complete the concrete repairs, water line vertical realignment, and storm drain crossing. Is this correct? If that is the case is slurry required, per COP 2-01P on the storm drain and water vertical re-alignment?

KWE Response - On Sheet D4.0 the storm drain alignment coincides with the 154 SF of valley gutter replacement, so no slurry should be anticipated with the storm drain construction. The water main vertical realignment occurs beyond new pavement, so slurry backfill should be included for this water main vertical realignment.

The Undersigned hereby declares that he has visited the site and has carefully examined the Contract Documents relating to the work covered by the above bid or bids.

The Bid Security (Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or Bid Bond) attached, payable to the City of Prescott in the sum of not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid price bid for the complete project, to insure that the undersigned, if his bid is accepted, shall enter into contract and give the bonds and certificates of insurance required. In the event that the contract and bonds and certificates of insurance required are not furnished to the City within the time required, then and in that event the City may retain from the bid bond an amount, not to exceed the amount of the bid bond, representing the difference between the amount specified in the proposal or bid, and such larger amount that the City in good faith contracts with another party to perform the work covered by the proposal or bid.

The project shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days after the starting date set forth in the NOTICE TO PROCEED.

The undersigned hereby declares, as bidder, that the only persons or parties interested in this PROPOSAL as principals are those named herein; that no elected official or employee of the City is in any manner interested directly or indirectly in this PROPOSAL or in the profits to be derived from the Contract proposed to be taken, other than as permitted by law; that this bid is made without any connection with any other person or persons making a separate bid for the same purpose; that the bid is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud; that he has read the NOTICE INVITING BIDS and the INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS hereto attached, and as more fully described in the attached contract and specifications, and agrees to furnish the items and perform the work called for

in accordance with the provisions of said form of Contract and the Specifications and to deliver the same within the time stipulated herein, and that he will accept in full payment therefore the total bid price named in this Proposal.

The bidder shall be an A-General Engineering contractor properly licensed at the time of bidding to perform construction in connection with fixed works, including streets, roads, power and utilities plants, dams, hydroelectric plants, sewage and waste disposal plants, bridges, tunnels, and overpasses and shall also be licensed to perform work within residential and commercial property lines, or shall be properly licensed to sub-contract residential or commercial work, as may be required in the Scope of Work.

Any bid submitted without the proper contracting license to perform the required work shall be considered non-responsive and rejected.

The bidder further agrees that, upon receipt of written notice of the acceptance of this PROPOSAL, he will execute the Contract in accordance with the PROPOSAL as accepted and furnish the required bonds TEN (10) days from the date of mailing of said notice of award to him at his address as given below, or within such additional time as may be allowed by the City; and that upon his failure or refusal to do so within said time, then the certified or cashier's check or bid bond accompanying this bid shall be cashed or enforced and the money payable pursuant thereto shall be forfeited to and become the property of the City as liquidated damages for such failure or refusal; provided that if said bidder shall execute the Contract and furnish the required bonds within the aforesaid time, his certified or cashier's check, if furnished, shall be returned to him within three (3) days thereafter, and the bid bond, if furnished, shall become void.

Bidder understands and agrees that the City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding.

The bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.
