Clarifications-

1.2 Generator Package Summary

F) Removal/Salvage: The package shall include the removal and salvage of five (5) existing Waukesha engines and accessories as described in Section 2.2.

- "Removal" means the physical removal of the Waukesha engines from the city facilities by means of crane or forklift. The city will have the engines disconnected from power, gas, plenums, and any building connections prior to the removal process.

4.4 TITLE: Prices are F.O.B. destination. Title to items and risk of loss remain with the Vendor until the City receives items at the delivery point.

- F.O.B. destination means the generator and switch have been delivered to 251 N. State Route 89, and have been set on the ground at the site by means of crane or forklift.

Questions-

Is there sales tax on the purchase of a used generator?

The purchase of the generator package falls under A.R.S. § 42-5061(B)(6) as tax exempt.
