Questions

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1. Current Retread Vendor, tread designs used and current pricing?

We currently do not have a contract in place.

2. Current Heavy Duty New Tire Vendor, tread designs used and current pricing?

We are currently using Northern AZ Tire for heavy duty tires; there is not a contract in place.

Michelin:XZUS2

Continental:HSU2, HSR2, HDL2, HDR, HTC1

General:Grabber OD

Pricing average for new is \$575.00 per tire.

Pricing average for recaps is \$190.00 (315)/\$165.00 (11R recap)

3. Do you know about how many tires you will be ordering each month?

The amounts will vary based on need but the following is an average:

- New-10/month
- Retread-35/month

4. Are they going to need them right away after bid is awarded? The reason why I ask is because if we have to order all 300 they will be coming in on a container and that takes about 90 days to come in. I want to bid accordingly.

Yes. We exclusively purchase domestic tires only.

5. I just wanted to clarify the tread design for the two sizes requested:

On page 3 under the retread services it lists "open shoulder on/off road construction/waste design".

Would you like a quote for this tread design for both sizes, both new AND retread?

Or, I can list other options—there is room on Form B – Price sheet...

Waste Hauler lug is our required recap tread.

You may list other options.

6. On the retreads –Do you need 32/32nds the reason I ask is the standard for waste hauler treads are 26 or 28/ 32nds.

32/32 is our preferred tread depth. A shallower tread is acceptable if the wear is comparable.

7. Do you need a three year lock on the price or will you review every year. Most of the city's contracts are 12 mo firm with review if there is a Industry wide increase. One good thing we have not seen an increase in over 5 yrs.

The contract will be a three year contracts with renewal periods that will be reviewed for price increases.

8. Can we bid the labor and tires separate or would you like it on the same bid.

You may bid separately.

9. Do you need estimated price per 32nds or price per mile on the retreads.

10. How many power units are there in your fleet check.
