**ANTELOPE HILLS GOLF CART ADVERTISING
MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

The City of Prescott gives notice of its intent to receive proposals from advertising firms for the purpose of providing advertising in the form of non-permanent banners (or similar format) on Antelope Hills golf carts. There are approximately 300+ golf carts currently in use. The City reserves the right to accept the proposal that best demonstrates the ability to perform in the best interests of the City as outlined in the proposal. Two copies and one original proposal must be submitted to the City Clerk at the Prescott City Hall located at 201 S. Cortez Street, Prescott, Arizona, 86303. Said proposals shall be submitted by 2:00 P.M. local time on December 29, 2006. All proposals will be opened at that place and time. Late proposals will be rejected unopened. The envelope or box containing the proposals must be sealed and clearly marked Antelope Hills Golf Cart Advertising Proposal. The City of Prescott reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, or to waive any irregularity.

1. The term of the contract shall be for one year from the contract execution date with two (2) additional, mutually agreed one (1) year renewals.
2. The City shall have the right of refusal of any advertisement that is deemed inappropriate by the Administrative Services Director or his designee (hereinafter referred to as "City").
3. Proposer must submit samples of advertising medium for the City to review.
4. Successful proposer shall have exclusive use of the property for advertising purposes for the term of the contract and any mutually agreed renewals.
5. Either party may terminate the contract upon giving a thirty (30) day written advanced notice to the other party.
