Background

On May 15 and May 22, 2016, the City of Prescott Public Works Department advertised the Transfer Station Slab Remediation Project. The project generally consists of the rehabilitation of the worn concrete floor and repairing the exposed edges of the solid waste transfer pit at the Transfer Station.

Bid Results

A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held on June 1, 2016, which was attended by two potential bidders. One bid was received with the following results:

Difference	\$148,200.00
Difference Percentage	52.93%
Engineer's estimate	\$218,100.00
Difference	\$210,100.00
Difference Percentage	96.33%

Recommendation

The bid received exceeds both the budgeted funding available for this project and the Engineer's Estimate. Accordingly, it is necessary to reject the bid.

The Solid Waste Division will work with the Public Works Department to potentially revise the approach to the repair work and to rebid the project as soon as possible.
