## PROJECT UPDATE RUNWAY 21L-3R RUNWAY SAFETY AREA IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

July 25, 2012 – updated 8/7/2012

Construction work continues to progress with the contractor performing work on the Southwest side of Runway 3R-21L, including the 3R approach safety area improvements. This safety area and associated markings is scheduled for completion by October 1, 2012.

The contractor is continuing the construction of Storm Drain parallel to Twy D from D-3 to D-6. Currently Twy D is closed North of the Tanker Base and D6 is also closed to facilitate the work across Twy D. The rolling closure continues as the contractor installs the Storm Drain moving toward the Rwy 3R end of the airport. Truck and equipment will be crossing Twy D in the vicinity of Twy D3, D4, and D5.

Runway 3R threshold has been temporarily relocated during the safety area work and will be marked in the permanent configuration on by late September. Then runway 21L will experience a displaced threshold for safety area work in October. The declared distances for both Rwy 3R and Rwy 21L will remain at **6,078' through October**.

The South Ramp transient parking has been relocated to the old terminal ramp between North Aire and the terminal, Guidance Aviation has been relocated to the northern half of the South Ramp. The southern half of the South Ramp is closed. Run ups for Rwy 3R should occur in the vicinity of Twy C at the South Ramp and Twy E between Twy D and Twy E3. The run up areas will be at the discretion of the ATCT.

NOTE: PRC airport will be closed for a 24-hour period on August 20 at 2000 to August 21 at 1959 (lcl) for pavement reconstruction at the intersection of runways 12-30 & 21L-3R. For clarification and to allow our tenants to continue to operate, when the closure of 3R/21L and 12/30 takes place beginning at 8:00 p.m. local August 20th, we will keep Runway 3L/21R open for the entire 24 hours. It will be NOTAMed open, and the runway lights will be on all night. Thank you to those of you who asked about this.

Please use caution for barricades, heavy equipment, and other vehicles operating in this vicinity.

Please remain aware of the NOTAMs for Prescott as they will be the official sources of information for airfield impacts.
