ZONE 27 UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS Project

The City of Prescott is proud to announce completion of the Zone 27 Reservoir, Piping & Pump station Project.

Project included the following,

- Construction of a new 1,250,000 gallon partially buried **Pre-stressed Reinforced Concrete Reservoir** tank that is designed to last over 50-years
- Removal of the existing 200,000 gallon above grade welded steel reservoir tank (green tank at corner on Skyline Drive) that was nearing its lifespan and re-vegetated the existing site
- Construction of waterline connection from the existing tank to the new tank location
- Construction of a new 1,340 GPM (Gallon Per Minute) pump station east of Casa Sanchez restaurant between the Southwest Car Wash and Thumb Butte Food Mart gas station
- Removal of the existing 400 gallon per minute pump station in the parking lot of Jim's Automotive at the corner of West Gurley Street and Idylwild Drive
- Construction of approximately 8,000 lf of new DIP waterline in Thumb Butte Road from West Gurley Street/Josephine Street to Sherwood Drive (just west of Hassayampa Village Lane)
- Construction of new waterlines on Country Club Circle and Plaza Drive
- Replacement of sewer line on Plaza Drive, Country Club Circle, Elwood Lane and Sherwood Drive due to waterline and utility conflicts.

The City of Prescott is proud to bring infrastructure improvement such as this to the Prescott community. Your support has been appreciated as crews worked to upgrade the Zone 27 utilities.
