Small Water Mains Upgrades

Small Water Mains Upgrades: To meet the basic infrastructure needs of providing for safe, adequate drinking water for the City's residents and businesses, the City annually budgets funds for the replacement and upgrade of small, undersized and aging water mains. These mains are typically 3" or less in diameter, often constructed of galvanized steel and also a source of leaks. Replacement of these lines improves the water system for our citizens, helps to reduce maintenance costs, water loss and improves fire flow.

Flatau Drive and Overstreet Drive, Leroux Street and Granite Street: CLM Earthmovers is the contractor. Construction started on June 1, 2010 on Flatau Drive and Overstreet Drive. CLM is finished installing the water main on Flatau, Overstreet, South Granite Street, and South Granite Street West. The water service lines are active on Flatau, and Overstreet. The old 2-inch water main in Flatau and Overstreet will be abandoned during the next week which will cause a temporary water outage in this area. The water main installation on Leroux is completed. All asphalt patching on Granite Street and Leroux will be completed by the end of this week. Private water services have been tied into the new water main and sewer line backwater valves have been installed in parcels that front Leroux Street. Clean up and landscape restoration is on going around all the construction areas. Rubber chip seal has been applied to Flatau and Overstreet.

Rodeo Grounds, Tolemac Drive to Wildwood Drive Connection and Ute Road: CLM Earthmovers is the contractor. Construction started on June 1, 2010 on Ute Road. The water main has been installed in Ute and all water service lines have been tied over to the new water main. Most of the work to be performed in the Rodeo Grounds is finished. Water services in the Rodeo Grounds have been tied over to the new water main this week. Paving has been completed in the Rodeo Grounds. The old 3-inch water line in the Rodeo Grounds will be abandoned during the next week however this should cause only very minimal water outages on Gail Gardner Way. The connection line between Tolemac Drive and Wildwood Drive is active. Restoration and clean up will be done in the areas of construction during the next two weeks.
