SMOKE TREE LANE PAVEMENT AND UTILITY UPGRADE PROJECT

July 1, 2015

The Smoke Tree Lane Pavement and Utility Upgrade Project generally consists of repaving Smoke Tree Lane from Willow Creek Road to Tabosa Drive, reconstructing the pavement structure on Smoke Tree Lane from Tabosa Drive to Birchwood Cove, and construction of a new 18" water transmission main in Smoke Tree Lane from Willow Creek Road to Birchwood Cove.

The engineering design contract was awarded to Kelley/Wise Engineering (KWE) at the January 28, 2014 council meeting. Design work is currently underway. Utility potholing on Smoke Tree Lane has been completed and evaluation of the data collected is underway. The plans are at the 60% level of completion and have been reviewed by staff. The plans have been returned to the engineer to advance to the 90% level.
