ROADWAY PROJECT

S. WASHINGTON AVENUE/GOODWIN STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

April 1, 2016

The S. Washington Avenue/Goodwin Street Improvements Project generally consists of constructing roadway and pedestrian access improvements along E. Goodwin Street from S. Mt. Vernon Avenue to Penn Avenue, and along S. Washington Avenue from Gurley Street to the southerly termination of S. Washington Avenue. Water, sewer and drainage replacements are also included.

Shephard-Wesnitzer Engineering was selected as the design engineer for this project. Contract negotiations have been completed. The engineering design contract was awarded at the July 14, 2015 City Council meeting. The design contract is anticipated to be completed in the Spring of 2016. Two public meetings are anticipated with the design.

Currently, Shephard-Wesnitzer Engineering has completed the 30% design plans and is finalizing the utility alignments. The Engineer is also looking at drainage improvements, a sediment catch basin at the south end of the project and replacement of the 80 year old culvert at Goodwin Street between Mount Vernon Avenue and Virginia Street. Additionally, we have included Steve Morgan, LA, Landscapes for Life to include landscaping features into the design.

The first community open house meeting will be at the Prescott Police Department, 222 Marina Street on April 7th, from 4:30 – 6:00 pm. The City of Prescott will be seeking feedback from the public on the project design.
