



Pressure Zone 39 Phase III Utility Upgrade Project Community Meeting Web Summary

April 21, 2010

On Wednesday, April 7, 2010, the City of Prescott held a public meeting for residents of the Pressure Zone 39 Phase III Utility Improvement project area. As part of an ongoing public involvement initiative associated with the project, this meeting was the fifth Community Meeting for the project. FANN Contracting, Inc., the project contractor, and the City made outreach efforts to area residents and property owners to inform residents of the construction process, schedule, and potential impacts as well as address project-related questions associated with the Zone 39 Phase III Utility Upgrade project.

Outreach efforts included a press release for local radio and newspaper coverage, a newspaper advertisement that ran in the *Prescott Daily Courier* on April 4th and April 7th, and a bulk mailing of 1,676 fliers to area residents in and around the work zone. Thirteen people signed in to the meeting, with a few of anonymous members of the public in attendance. The Community Meeting featured members of the project team, project information, and display boards that had information regarding the Zone 39 Construction project area, Indian Hill reservoir design plans, and anticipated project schedule. Brief presentations were given by the City of Prescott, FANN Contracting, and the Prescott Fire Department to provide project background, scheduling, and fire contingency plan information.

After the presentation, meeting attendees were able to ask the project team questions during the question and answer session with City of Prescott and FANN Contracting staff. Project team members were identified by name badges and were available to discuss the informational boards with the public and answer questions individually. One person submitted a comment at the meeting. All communication between the public and the project team was positive, with members of the public appreciative of the project information and public outreach efforts.

The final meeting in the public involvement effort for the Zone 39 Phase III Utility Upgrade Project was a success. All public input gathered has been considered by the project team as it moves forward into the final phase of construction, which is the installation of a new 1.33-million-gallon water reservoir at the summit of Indian Hill.
