**WATER LINE INSTALLATION**

**Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 29<sup>th</sup>  
7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.**

With the final overlay paving finished, the Zone 39 Phase I Construction is significantly complete. Minor grading and miscellaneous punchlist work associated with the project will be performed over the next week, but no major traffic impacts are anticipated. Area residents and motorists should remain alert for construction traffic during this time.

Lanes may be restricted where crews are working.

**PIONEER PUMP STATION**

**Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 29<sup>th</sup>  
7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.**

Following the successful completion of all tests of the new pump station and the fire flow tests, the new Pioneer Pump Station is now online. Contractor will perform miscellaneous punchlist work inside and outside of the Pump Station and some landscaping work is scheduled for next week.

Lanes may be restricted where crews are working. Motorists should remain alert for construction workers and equipment at the intersection of Pioneer Drive and Hassayampa Drive and should follow well-marked detours. Please drive slowly and safely along detour routes.

<b>Description of work performed and traffic impact:</b>	<p><b><u>Country Club, Street and Utility Improvements</u></b></p> <p><b>Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> through Friday, July 30<sup>th</sup> from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.</b></p> <p>Paving is complete along Country Club Drive from Vista Drive to Verde Lane. Crews may be working throughout the project area performing miscellaneous punchlist work required to finish Phase II and prepare for chip seal placement. This work may require traffic control where needed.</p> <p><b><u>Zone 39 Phase III</u></b></p> <p>With demolition and removal of the existing water reservoir atop Indian Hill complete, construction of the new 1.33 MG reservoir has begun. Crews completed installing the ringwall and the retaining walls for the new reservoir and continue the installation of a 16-inch water line and storm drain pipe throughout the week. The water line will connect the new reservoir to the new water mains along Country Club Drive. Paso Robles Tank company is scheduled to continue with the construction of the steel structure of the new reservoir over the next two weeks.</p> <p>Trucks hauling materials to and from the site will be traveling along Country Club Drive from Park Avenue to Indian Hill. Please be aware of the following. While work will largely occur off the roadway, occasional, short-term traffic impacts may be experienced at the Indian Hill access road and Country Club intersection. Residents should use caution moving through the project area and be aware of construction traffic.</p> <p><b><u>PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RESTRICTIONS</u></b></p> <p>Due to safety concerns, pedestrian access through the work zone is prohibited for the duration of Phase III. This means that the access road to the summit of Indian Hill is closed to recreational use.</p>
