### **Tuesday, February 2**

**“Greenways”** – Two mile out and back trail along granite creek to mile high middle school, with lots of foliage and deciduous trees. Group will meet for coffee after hike.

Level: 1

Directions: Park in the Albertson’s Shopping Center near Staples. Path to park is located on sidewalk next to Staples.

### **Thursday, February 4**

**“Willow Peninsula Trails”** - Take a hike around the lake, through the Cottonwood Peninsula and old shooting club ruins. Turn around after a half-hour

Level: 1.5

Directions: Meet behind Willow Creek Park/ Dog Park at trailhead. Dog Park is located off Willow Creek Rd, across from the auto dealerships.

### **Tuesday, February 9**

**“Panorama Trail”** – Out and back trail with fantastic views and petroglyphs. 2miles

Level: 2.5

Directions: Take Smoketree from Prescott Lakes Parkway or Willow Creek Road, go north on Sarafina to Vista Park and playground.

### **Thursday, February 11**

**"Willow Loop Trail"**- Dells trail that follows the Willow Lake shoreline to the Dam with steep ups and downs and great views of the lake.

Level: 4+

Directions: Take Willow Creek Road to Heritage Park Road (across from ERAU). Turn right the right then right again, head past the kiosk, turn right again and park at the parking lot by the Willow Lake boat dock.

**Tuesday, February 16**

**“Constellation Trail”**-Many loop options in the Granite Dells with great views.

Level: 3

Directions: Parking area off of Highway 89 north of the roundabout and south of Highway 89A at the Phippen Museum (4701 N State Route 89). Park in the improved lot area next to Phippen Museum.

**Thursday, February 18**

**“Pioneer Park Trails”** – A fairly flat loop trail, south of the softball fields, with some good size hills.

Level: 2.5

Directions: Turn left onto Commerce Drive from Willow Creek Road next to Tim’s dealership. Park by the “mountain lion” on the left just before the ball fields.

**Tuesday, February 23**

**“Watson Lake”** – Trail goes from Ramada in Watson Lake Park to Watson Woods and back.

Level: 2.5

Directions: Watson Lake Park is 4 miles out Highway 89 toward Chino Valley at the intersection of Hwy 89 and Willow Lake Road. Go into the park to the large Ramada at the top of the hill.

**Thursday, February 25**

**“Northshore and Flume Trail”**– Trail starts at old boat ramp at Watson Lake and heads north to Watson Dam Trail. Will continue to the Flume Trail and back to the boat dock.

Level: 4

Directions: Go into Watson Lake Park from the roundabout on Highway 89; continue straight past the large field on the left hand side. Park on the east side of the field and we will walk to the boat ramp.
