




# United States Tennis Association USTA 36' -60' Project

The City of Prescott Parks & Recreation Department is offering this new beginner youth tennis program sponsored by the USTA for all children ages 5-8 (36' project) and 13 & under (60' project).



**36' Project:** The USTA has created this new youth program designed to instruct participants ages 5-8 years in a fun format. This program has a 36' X 18' court with a 2'9" net to give your youngster confidence by hitting a specialized dense foam ball over a scaled down tennis court. This successful new program offers children who have never played before the ability to rally back and forth with confidence.



**60' Project:** The 60' project is designed for ages 13 and under or the 5-8 year olds who have participated in the 36' project to graduate to a larger 60' x 21' court with low compression balls made especially for this size court to give the players a chance to continue to improve their skills with confidence.
