

How much do off-site sign permits cost and where can I purchase one?

For more than two signs (up to a maximum of seven) to display between 6 am Friday to 7 pm Sunday

\$50.00 per Sign

Permit for extended display times beyond Friday—Sunday

\$200.00 per sign

Permit for more than two signs and extended display

\$250.00 per sign

The above permits are valid for one year from time of purchase.

WHAT IF I NEED SIGNS FOR: AN ESTATE SALE, REAL ESTATE SHOWING OR A YARD SALE?

Off-site signs within the right-of-way for yard sales, estate sales or missing animals are allowed, but subject to the following limitations and conditions:



Signs cannot be associated with an adjacent business.



Signs must be for events or sales that do not take place on an ongoing basis or at a permanent

location.

Offsite signs are not allowed for businesses that have an ongoing business that takes place on a continuing basis at a permanent location.

Signs may be no more than 21 inches by 27 inches, including all structures or objects upon which the sign is placed or located.



Permits for up to five additional signs are available at a cost of \$50 per sign per year.




If placed on a sidewalk, a sign must be placed in such a manner that it allows a minimum of 48 inches of unobstructed travel on the sidewalk.



Signs are allowed between the hours of 6 am Friday to 7 pm Sunday only, unless a permit is obtained from the city for extended times. Permits

for up to a total of seven signs for extended periods may be obtained from the city at a cost of \$200.00 per sign per year.



Signs must be of weather-resistant material. Paper and cardboard are prohibited.



The following signs are prohibited: Any sign emitting sound, containing light bulbs, balloons, or signs with intermittent or flashing illumination, or animated or moving signs.



No signs may be located within a street, public trail, city planter, roadway or other thoroughfare, nor may any sign be affixed to a tree, traffic sign, traffic control device or utility pole.



All signs placed in the right-of-way must contain the name and address of the individual placing the sign, unless that sign has a

permit affixed to it that was issued by the City of Prescott. No off-site signs are permitted in downtown Prescott.
