



PRESCOTT: DOING THE RIGHT THING TO BE GREEN

Prescott has long been mindful of its special environmental surroundings; here's just a look at a few ways in which the City has responded to preserving the Prescott way of life.

- * 1990's City begins Open Space Program
- * 2002: City implements the Urban Wildlife Interface for Fire Protection
- * 2003: City develops Bicycle/Pedestrian Master Plan (being revised in 2009)
- * February 2006: City Appoints Full time Water Conservation Coordinator
- * March 2008: City becomes National Member of the United States Green Build Council (USGBC)
- * City sponsors local USGBC Provisional Branch in First Annual regional energy-fair
- * City to enact 2006 International Energy Conservation Code in early 2009
- * City dedicates Planning/Building Staff to Environmental/Sustainable initiatives
- * 2008: City introduces SmartCodes to Community
- * 2008: City/County receives "Great Public Spaces" award from the American Planning Association for the Yavapai County Courthouse Plaza
- * 2008: Local Transit Voucher Program receives continued ADOT funding (Program has been in place since 2002)
