Community Meeting planned for Zone 19 utility improvements

PRESCOTT, Ariz. – The City of Prescott is hosting a Community Meeting for the Zone 19 Utility Improvements Project. The meeting will take place Wed, Feb. 29 from 5:30-7 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall at Trinity Presbyterian Church, 630 Park Ave.

The City of Prescott has designed upgrades to aging and undersized water service infrastructure in the Thumb Butte area. The proposed designs will improve service to pressure Zone 19 by adding a new, 1-million-gallon capacity storage reservoir, replacing the Zone 19 pump station, and extending water mains along Copper Basin Road and Wickwood Lane. These improvements ensure adequate water delivery for existing customers, allow for future water needs, and increase available “fire flow” necessary to maintain a fire-safe community.

The public is encouraged to attend the Community Meeting on Wed, Feb. 29 to learn more about the proposed designs and project scheduling. Doors open at 5:30 p.m., with a short presentation detailing the improvements to follow.
