SITE USE GUIDELINES

Thank you for your interest in the Community Nature Center of Prescott. The Community Nature Center is a *very unique* 18 acre site! The site is owned and managed by the City of Prescott. Volunteers assist with interpretation of the natural values, maintenance, and monitoring of this site.

Any groups over the size of 10 participants are asked to notify the City of Prescott Parks and Recreation Department. Please call the City of Prescott Parks & Recreation at 928-777-1122 to discuss your event and to get on the schedule. We will need to know the size of the group and planned activities.

This site is reserved for nature study, and the land is fragile! **Please note that users must:**

- Pick up pet waste, and keep dogs leashed at all times.
- Stay on the established trails and off the rocks.
- Stay off open areas between the trail loops. The open areas with native grasses are very fragile, please do not cross these, or use these for any activities. Even limited foot-traffic or occasional use can damage delicate microbiotic flora and native grasses.
- Not drive into the site for any reason. Site access is for emergency vehicles only.
- Not move benches, chairs or tables from their locations.
- Refrain from taking any samples of plants, animals or rocks.
- Not handle any animals, including reptiles such as horned lizards. They are easily damaged as well.
- Not remove any organisms from the pond.
- Use only the porta-potty facilities for human waste.
- Use included trashcans near the cabin for trash, or preferably pack out all trash generated from your event.
