ROADWAY PROJECT

FY18 VARIOUS DRAINAGE AND STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

October 18, 2018

The project is currently under design and has been awarded to Kimley-Horn.

The project consists of various drainage improvements associated with street drainage and neighborhood complaints regarding drainage. The projects have been split into four separate bid packages in an effort to obtain more competitive bidding for the construction projects.

- Bid Packet #1 includes Alarcon Alley #1, Divinity Drive, 5587 and Goldenrod Way. The project has been bid out and awarded to Earth Resources Corporation (ERC) for construction. ERC has completed both the Alarcon Alley (between Alarcon and Pleasant, south of Aubrey Street) and the outlet structure near Goldenrod Way. Work on Divinity Drive and cleaning out a drainage ditch on Sarafina Drive will start in October.
- Bid Packet #2 includes 915 Country Club Drive, 1816 Boardwalk Avenue and the Thumb Butte Road curbing (west of Apollo Heights Drive). Kimley-Horn has currently completed the 100% plans, and City staff is currently reviewing the plans. The project should be bid out in October.
- Samaritan Way Road Reconstruction has been awarded to Fann Contracting under a Job Order Contract. The construction project was completed in July.
- Robinson Drive Storm Drain off Hillcrest Lane. Kimley-Horn has finalized the plan and the project has been awarded to Capital Improvements, the same contractor that was awarded the Robinson Drive Reconstruction Contract. Construction will start in November and will last for 3 months.
