Monitoring Update

1. Due to the federal government partial shutdown in late Dec 2018/early Jan 2019, the two United States Geological Survey (USGS) reports are delayed; revised release dates to the public expected in April/May 2019.
2. Matrix New World is working with Mr. Larson to acquire the one (1) acre parcel where monitor well MW-4g was drilled.
3. The CA1 parties are actively assessing the Big Chino Data Collection and Monitoring Plan to determine if all objectives have been met or will be met by 2020.
4. Golder & Associated Technical Memo on the model construction is in progress
5. A Multi-Agency Stakeholders Meeting is planned for July 2019 (hosted in Prescott by the City)
