


City of Prescott truck route ordinances

City of Prescott city code – 8-1-8 thru 8-8-7

The use of public roads within the city is to serve the needs of our citizens.

Safety, noise and keeping our traffic flowing at a moderate pace is a prime concern.

As our streets were laid out 100 plus years ago, Our truck route ordinance is designed to address these concerns by limiting truck traffic in our down town area.

These ordinances were designed to permit reasonable movement of trucks and to assist in keeping our streets functioning safely, clean and to limit repairs.

Definition:

Truck: Any commercial motor vehicle having a rated chassis in excess of one (1) ton and is used primarily for moving property or passengers or equipment . Also included is a vehicle described above , towing a trailer.

Through Truck Route: A way over certain streets, as designated herein, over and along which trucks coming into and going out of the city must operate unless otherwise exempted pursuant to Sections 8-8-5 or 8-8-6.

Local Truck Route: Those streets or roads which shall be used by a truck to arrive at an in-city destination which is not located on a Through Truck Route or to reach a Through Truck Route when departing from an in-city origination when the point of origination is not on a Through Truck Route.

Requirements: Trucks must operate on designated truck routes.

Exceptions:

1. If a detour directs you off of the truck route.
2. If your in city destination is off of the truck route, you shall proceed by the shortest reasonable route to your destination and then by shortest route return to the truck route.
3. If you have multiple destinations in the down town area

Fines:

Violation of the Truck Route Ordinance is a Civil Traffic violation and is subject to a sanction of \$50.00 and up to \$2500.00 .
