3. **CALL TO ENTER INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION**
Upon a public majority vote of the members constituting a quorum, the Council Subcommittee may hold an executive session that is not open to the public for the purposes set forth below. When the executive session ends, Council Subcommittee may adjourn or return to open session.
4. **EXECUTIVE SESSION**
 1. Legal advice from the City's attorneys and discussion or consideration of employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, salaries, disciplining or resignation of a public officer, appointee or employee of any public body, except that, with the exception of salary discussions, an officer, appointee or employee may demand that the discussion or consideration occur at a public meeting. The public body shall provide the officer, appointee or employee with written notice of the executive session as is appropriate but not less than twenty-four hours for the officer, appointee or employee to determine whether the discussion or consideration should occur at a public meeting. A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(1) & (3):

Discussion, consideration, and recommendation of appointments for the Advisory & Appeals Board, CDBG Citizens Advisory Committee, Fire

Board of Appeals, Industrial Development Authority, Pedestrian Bicycle and Traffic Advisory Committee, Planning & Zoning Commission, Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Board- Fire, Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Board- Police, Tourism Advisory Committee, and Youth Advisory Board; and appointment of Chair & Vice Chair for the Advisory & Appeals Board, Fire Board of Appeals, Planning & Zoning Commission and Youth Advisory Board.

6. Reconvene Council Subcommittee for Appointments

A. Consider recommendations for the Advisory & Appeals Board, CDBG Citizens Advisory Committee, Fire Board of Appeals, Industrial Development Authority, Pedestrian Bicycle and Traffic Advisory Committee, Planning & Zoning Commission, Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Board- Fire, Public Safety Personnel Retirement System Board- Police, Tourism Advisory Committee, and Youth Advisory Board; and appointment of Chair & Vice Chair for the Advisory & Appeals Board, Fire Board of Appeals, Planning & Zoning Commission and Youth Advisory Board.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Upon a public majority vote of a quorum of the Council Appointment Committee, the Committee may hold an executive session, which will not be open to the public, regarding any item listed on the agenda but only for the following purposes:

- (i) Discussion or consideration of personnel matters (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(1));
- (ii) Discussion or consultation for legal advice with the city's attorneys (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3));
- (iii) Discussion or consultation with the city's attorneys regarding the city's position regarding contracts that are the subject of negotiations, in pending or contemplated litigation, or in settlement discussions conducted in order to avoid litigation (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(4));
- (iv) Discussion or consultation with designated representatives of the city to consider its position and instruct its representatives regarding negotiations with employee organizations (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(5));
- (v) Discussion, consultation or consideration for negotiations by the city or its designated representatives with members of a tribal council, or its designated representatives, of an Indian reservation located within or adjacent to the city (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(6));
- (vi) Discussion or consultation with designated representatives of the city to consider its position and instruct its representatives regarding negotiations for the purchase, sale or lease of real property (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(7)).

Confidentiality

Arizona statute precludes any person receiving executive session information from disclosing that information except as allowed by law. A.R.S. §38-431.03(F). Each violation of this statute is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$500, plus court costs and attorneys' fees. This penalty is assessed against the person who violates this statute or who knowingly aids, agrees to aid or attempts to aid another person in violating this article. The city is precluded from expending any public monies to employ or retain legal counsel to provide legal services or representation to the

public body or any of its officers in any legal action commenced for violation of the statute unless City Council takes a legal action at a properly noticed open meeting to approve of such expenditures prior to incurring any such obligation or indebtedness. A.R.S. §38-431.07(A)(B).
