Minutes of the Mayor's Commission on Well-Being held on Wednesday, June 10, 2020 from City Council Chambers at 201 S. Cortez Prescott, Arizona.

4. **Public Comments-**

Logo designs from Lynette were accepted as input and distributed to the commission.

5. **Fall Launch Event**

Include Logo and completed survey questions. Kristy says Lynette's contributions can be utilized for the website. Will discuss on future agenda. Billie met with web master and had the resource guide removed.
Bonnie says she was unclear as to the launch event, whether we are launching the survey versus hosting an event. Terri thought the same. Discussion on how to launch the survey.

Bonnie suggests we use the survey results to help spread the word about the survey. She interpreted the Fall Launch Event to be about an event to announce the Commission. Discussion about the home show. Peg says at this time YCCA is undecided if it will happen. John says thought that the 2200 emails were for the launch of the survey. Discussion on the need for clarification on Fall launch event and survey launch, Billie says she will talk with John H. Discussion on the need for the website to be available at the same time as the survey launches. Peg says they can get with John H. to ensure the site is ready and then move forward. Kristy suggests having a call to the public for art submissions, photos, etc. How should we do that? PSA's. Blank area on the website saying "your submission here"? Vickie says social media would be effective. Group agrees to ask John H. how to assist with this.

Fall launch event- (independent to the survey launch)

Kristy asks Terri if she has any insights into what COVID-19 will look like come Fall. Discussion. Terri suggests a Chamber mixer as to keep the overhead low. Billie suggests maybe using the upper ramada at Watson Lake. Cecelia says Forest Villas has been at full occupancy and it's important to take responsibility for themselves.

Peg says if they are planning a Fall event to have it outdoors, provide masks, keep physical distancing. Kristy asks about modeling an event after the outdoor events like AZGFD hosts. Billie mentions the home show and Peg believes it won't continue this year. Terri offers promoting the event on the County social media since its health & well-being related. Peg suggests adding the event planning to the next agenda. She says pickle ball is still planning events, implementing safety precautions. Kristy says the outdoor event is the safest option.

6. Prescott Living Article

Include call to public for art/photo submissions. Focus on website, logo, and call to public. Billie says she will take that on. The new article is proofed and ready to go out. Peg suggests having someone help Billie with the next one.

7. Well-being Podcast

John M says wisdom series focusing on each pillar of well-being with experts from the community talking. Peg asks where would this be done. John says it would be an online/zoom type format. Kristy gives the example of John M & Ken Lain from Watters would engage in a prompted interview with audio and video. No public comment is typically included. Total amounts of podcasts is no matter. Billie says we have plenty of folks in the community to participate. Peg asks if someone would like to take the lead. John M says he will and says we need to vet all topics through John H. Kristy says a benefit of podcasts is they are not live material and can be edited. Billie loves the idea.

Peg suggests getting 1-2 interviewees per each pillar/topic.

Vickie motions to proceed with podcast development to educate and inform the public.

Kristy seconds.

All agree.

Kristy offers to help John M and Vickie with the podcasts.


9. ADJOURNMENT
