- C. Approval of Minutes from regular meeting on July 26, 2019. Motion made to approve by Ron Miller, seconded by Thomas Restifo, all in favor, approved.
- D. Discussion and consideration of mural art agreement for Whiskey Row Alley. Tyler Goodman presented art agreement from Juliana Hutchins, per Tyler this will still go to Council in September or October. Juliana says it will take about 6 weeks to complete, they, she and Dana, will start soon within the next week. Tyler said that they met with the historic preservation commission, because building is original Prescott brick; therefore the mural will be painted on aluminum composite sign materials and they will be installed over the bricks. These same composite sign materials are in the holiday courtyard. The composite signs will be hung into the mortar, no holes in brick. Tyler presented a photo rendering of what the mural will look like. Ron asked if City staff is ok with the project, Tyler said yes. Tyler also stated that donations of \$2,000 of the \$6,500 needed have been received and he will be starting a public donation campaign soon, with different levels of giving presented. Ron Miller made a motion that the Art Committee accept the art agreement with no changes, seconded by Alexandra Rudolph, all in favor, approved.
