C. Approval of Minutes from regular meeting on July 22, 2020. Motion made to approve by Ron Miller, seconded by Cindi, all in favor, approved.


D. Discussion and consideration of Letter of Intent and Art Donation Agreement from Jim Chamberlain for "Checkmate". Ron, Roger, and Cindi have seen this piece at the Phippen Museum and Ron expressed that this is a good piece for the round-a-bout. Ron asked who will be paying for the costs associated with moving the piece, who will move the piece, and who will pay for the foundation. Ron stated that typically the donor pays for the concrete foundation. Shannon said Jim Chamberlain will be paying for the lights, plants, and irrigation for the plants in the round-a-bout. Roger asked who would make the decision about which direction the piece is placed. Alex said that in the past, the Bronzsmith made the decision. Ron asked if Jim Chamberlain is the owner of the statue, Shannon said yes, he has loaned it to the Phippen. Ron asked about potential for landscape repairs to the Phippen property when the piece is moved. Shannon said that the Phippen wants to move another piece to the space where "Checkmate" is. The base will be rebuilt when "Checkmate" is moved. Shannon will check to see who will be responsible for costs if Phippen spot is damaged. Shannon



Ron made a motion to postpone a motion to approve until the committee gets more information from City Public Works and Shannon Lovdahl about who is paying for the costs of the foundation, costs for the movement of the piece, who will move the piece, and any repairs that may be needed at the Phippen after the piece is moved, Alex seconded, all in favor, approved.
