C. Approval of the November 18, 2020 meeting minutes

Tessa Dunn motioned to approve, Emma Tenney seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

D. Presentation on the Fire Department by Chief Light

The department is 135 years old. While they are a fire department, they do all risk. 65% are EMS calls and only 5% are fire calls. They do all types of rescues, deal with hazardous materials, and tactical medical services with the Police Department SWOT. 10,000 calls for service annually. There are five fire stations throughout the city. \$9.6M budget for FY20 and a similar budget for FY21. Personnel costs are the most significant item in the budget. A fire engine costs about \$600,000 but the life of a truck can be 17 years as it performs different duties. The department is now accredited and that is a big professional achievement.

E. Discuss Coffee with a Cop for Teens

The goal is to do it in person and in February. The group will discuss this as that gets closer.

F. Discuss the Teen Task Force Projects

Look at the Community Club in January when school comes back (during spring semester).

The schools and administrations are on board with this. Steps to take next:

- Spread the word (all will work with the social media accounts at their schools to share messages)
- Tessa will work on a flier that can be shared on social media and otherwise
- First meeting date for Community Club will be decided as items are finalized

The logo contest is still a possibility. Tessa hasn't received submissions yet, but Emma's teacher has received some and will get those to her. For judging the art, the board would vote on them (or at least 3 finalists) and then have Mayor Mengarelli or the Council decides on a winner. Tyler will add agenda item for the board to look at these and vote on them in January. Emma will compile those from other members. Nicholas will submit to Emma the submissions.

Finalize the Community Club information to send out




Tyler will invite IT director to speak for 10 minutes at the next meeting
