Discussion and consideration of Letter of Intent and Art Donation Agreement from William DeRouchev for donation of "a real antique wooden propeller" and photograph of "a ridged metal radial engine" which will displayed on the wall together. Roger asked if the weight of the two pieces needs to be considered. Ron stated that the artwork will be a printed photograph of the engine, not an actual engine. The propeller is an antique wooden propeller which will be mounted in front of the photograph of the engine. The photograph of the engine will be printed on material that will make it look like a real metal, engine. Roger asked if the metal print is the best representation. Alex thinks this is the best representation. Ron made motion to accept, seconded by Alex, all in favor approved.
