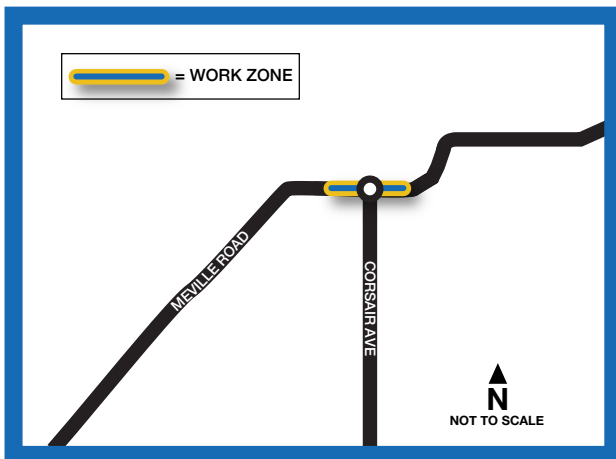


CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY CONTINUES AT MELVILLE AND CORSAIR AVENUE



Work is scheduled to occur with the following activities:

Starting Monday, June 13 crews will begin the removal of existing pavement and roundabout at the intersection. Non-construction traffic north of the project will be redirected to use Ruger Road. Fence removal and replacement is expected to occur over the next two weeks and utility relocation and pothole work is also ongoing. The work will widen Melville Road to provide necessary access to new industrial businesses to the northeast.

Flaggers will be present during work hours and minimal delays are expected. Work hours are Monday through Thursday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. The City of Prescott advises drivers to slow down in work zones and use caution around construction personnel and equipment while work is underway.

Construction personnel will work with businesses to provide access throughout the project; however, access may be limited intermittently.

The project is expected to be complete by mid-October.
