Streets Division Snow Equipment Facility

SEPTEMBER 6, 2022

As the Sundog Wastewater Treatment Plant at 1500 Sundog Ranch Road is decommissioned and operations relocated to the Airport Water Reclamation Facility, portions of the old site will be repurposed. The Streets Maintenance Division will be incrementally relocating their operations to vacated portions of the old treatment plant.

The project will be constructed in phases. The first phase of the Streets Department relocation involved demolishing four decommissioned, concrete sludge beds and back filling them with crushed miscellaneous base material. The next phase will involve designing the new Street Division Snow Equipment Facility.

The second phase of construction will involve construction of a concrete slab on grade and the installation of the spreader racks and associated snow removal equipment. The design is such that a building can be constructed in subsequent phases to enclose the spreader racks and other snow removal equipment and materials and protect City employees from inclement weather while gearing up for snow removal.

Kimley-Horn is the engineering design firm. The plans and bid documents have been completed. Advertising for construction bids started on June 26, 2022, and the bid opening was on August 4, 2022. The bids are currently under review.
