Top 12 Family Friendly Trails in Prescott, Arizona Directions & Amenities



Nature Niños is a family resource & accessibility initiative of the City of Prescott Recreation Services Department & Community Nature Center, Yavapai County Community Health Services, and the University of Arizona Cooperative-Yavapai. These trails have been determined to be the most accessible and engaging for families with young children. They are all located within City of Prescott except for the Highlands Center for Natural History which is in the nearby Prescott National Forest.

AC Williams Granite Creek Park & Splash Pad

Location: 554 6th Street accesses the Park and Trail System. For parking directly adjacent to the Splash Pad, turn off West Willis Street onto North Granite Street and drive to the end of the road.

Amenities: Free Parking, Stroller-Accessible, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Storywalk, Creek Access, Downtown Walking Access

Jim McCasland Willow Creek Park

Location: 3181 Willow Creek Road. Turn off Willow Creek Road, drive past the Dog Park to park in the left parking lot. Trailhead is located just past the baseball field.

Amenities: Free Parking, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Dog Park, Creek and Lake Access

Acker Park

Location: 421 South Virginia Street. Turn South on Virginia Street from Gurley Street. Drive past the houses to access the paved pullout parking area on the left side of the road.

Amenities: Free Parking, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Storywalk

Stricklin Park & Butte Creek Trail

Location: 1730 Sherwood Drive. Turn off Gurley Street onto Sherwood Drive; drive around the corner and park along the street.

Amenities: Free Parking, Seating, Creek Access, Archeological Interpretive Site, Trail Maps

Pioneer Park & Brown Low Trails

Location: 1200 Commerce Drive. Turn off of Willow Creek Road onto Commerce Drive. Turn left into gravel parking lot for trail access. Turn right into a paved parking lot for playground access.

Amenities: Free Parking, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Changing Table, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Large Fields, Trail Maps



Vista Park

Location: 1684 Sarafina Drive. Turn off of Prescott Lakes Parkway onto East Smoke Tree Lane, then turn onto Sarafina Drive. Paved parking lot on the left for park and trail access.

Amenities: Free Parking, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Near Solstice Mesa Petroglyphs

Constellation Trails

Location: 5761 Arizona Highway 89. Turn off of Highway 89 at the roundabout across the Highway from the Phippen Museum. Park in the gravel parking lot.

Amenities: Free Wednesday Parking, Drinking Water, Flushable Toilets, Historical Interpretive Site

Community Nature Center

Location: 1981 Williamson Valley Road. Turn off of Iron Springs Road onto Williamson Valley Road. Drive past two schools and turn right onto Granite Mountain School Road. There is a small wooden sign for the nature center. Park in the gravel parking lot on the left.

Amenities: Free Parking, Stroller-Accessible Trail, Portable Toilets, Seating, Picnic Areas, Nature Play Area, Historical and Natural Interpretive Sites, Pond Access, Trail Maps

Highlands Center for Natural History

Location: 1375 S Walker Rd. Turn off of Arizona Highway 89 onto Walker Road. Drive 1.8 miles to gravel parking lot on the left.

Amenities: Free Parking, Stroller-Accessible Trail, Flushable Toilet, Seating, Picnic Areas, Nature Play Area, Natural Interpretive Sites, Creek Access

Peavine Trail

Location: 1624 Sundog Ranch Road. Turn off of Arizona Highway 89 onto Prescott Lakes Parkway going East. Then turn North onto Sundog Ranch Road. Park in the gravel parking lot on the left.

Amenities: Free Wednesday Parking, Flushable Toilets, Drinking Water, Trail Maps, Seating, Picnic Areas

Heritage Park & Willow Lake Trails

Location: 1497 Heritage Park Road. Turn off of Willow Creek Road onto Heritage Park Road near the Zoological Sanctuary. Continue straight to paved parking for the play area and fields, or turn right onto Heritage Park Creek Road to paved parking, ramadas, and Willow Lake Trail access.

Amenities: Free Wednesday Parking, Flushable Toilets, Drinking Water, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Large Fields, Boat Launch, Trail Maps

Goldwater Lake

Location: 2900 South Goldwater Road. Turn off of Gurley Street Road onto Mt. Vernon Street/Senator Highway. Drive 4 miles to South Goldwater Lake Road. Turn right and continue to paved parking area.

Amenities: Free Wednesday Parking, Vault Toilets, Drinking Water, Seating, Picnic Areas, Play Areas, Boat Launch
