**Permit Conditions**

1. The quantity of water recovered shall be reported to the Arizona Department of Water Resources, 1110 W. Washington St., Suite 310, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 in the form of annual data reports. The annual report shall be submitted no later than March 31 following the end of each completed annual reporting period. The first annual reporting period shall be from the effective date of this permit through December 31, 2020. Subsequent annual reporting periods shall be January 1 through December 31.

2. The annual report shall include the following information:
  - a. The well registration numbers, and locations of the wells used to recover stored water.
  - b. For each recovery well from which stored water was recovered during the year, the quantity of stored water recovered from the well, as measured in a manner consistent with the requirements and specifications for water measuring devices adopted pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-872.01; the Water Storage Permit Number(s) from which the water storage originated; the amount of recovery (in acre feet) attributed to each Water Storage Permit; the amount and source of stored water recovered on an annual basis; and the amount and source of stored water recovered from a long-term storage account.
  - c. For each recovery well from which water was recovered during the year, indicate whether recovery occurred inside or outside the area of impact of the stored water.
3. Total withdrawals from well 55-212087, including all production and recovery regardless of ownership, shall not exceed the annual volume limit of 1,694 acre-feet. Additionally, pursuant to A.A.C. R12-15-1303.C.2, at the end of any year that the permittee chooses to recover stored water from well 55-212087 there must be a minimum of 4,885 acre-feet of long-term storage credits in its long-term storage account that were earned from storage at the City of Prescott Recharge Facility, permit number 71-519567.
4. Total withdrawals from the wells referenced below, including all *production and recovery* regardless of ownership, shall not exceed the following specified annual volume limits:

5. Recovery of stored water shall be consistent with the management plan and achievement of the management goal for the Prescott Active Management Area for the duration of this permit.
6. Permittee may only recover the following:
  - a. Water stored by permittee in the Prescott Active Management Area pursuant to permittee’s Water Storage Permits or
  - b. Long-term storage credits originating from water stored by another person pursuant to a water storage permit in the Prescott AMA, that have been assigned to permittee’s long-term storage account pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-854.01.

7. If ownership of the wells listed above changes at any time after the permittee has applied for this recovery well permit, the permittee shall submit to the Department written consent from the new well owner or other documentation that the permittee may legally continue to operate the well as its recovery well.
