

## Part A – General Information Attachment A1

This application is for a modification of the Designation of Assured Water Supply for the City of Prescott, Arizona. On December 31, 2009, the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued Decision and Order AWS No. 2008-006 (No. 86-401501.0001) which modified Prescott's previous Designation status. The primary purpose of No. 86-401501.0001 was the inclusion of the supplies related to the City's acquisition of Big Chino Water Ranch (BCWR). The purpose of this application is to provide required information as the City has reached one of the conditions in Section IV. Order of Designation and Conditions of Designation, Condition 4,

If Prescott does not submit to the Department on or before December 31, 2019, evidence that ADEQ has issued an AOC for the pipeline, **Prescott shall submit an application to modify** this decision and order designating Prescott as having an assured water supply when the sum of Prescott's current demand, committed demand, and two-year projected demand exceeds 16,397 acre-feet per year, or **by December 31, 2021**, whichever is earlier.

In preparation for this modification, the City entered a contract (circa 2016) to develop a long-term Water Resources Management Model, (WRMM), not only to assimilate high volumes of data for City water management purposes, but to support this application with both data sets that can be reproduced and represented with industry standard GIS software. This WRMM has a version dedicated and specifically tailored to follow the requirements for designation modification. Overall, the City is applying for a small increase to its groundwater allowance (approximately 481.32 AF), and updates to its existing surface water and effluent supplies. The City seeks to retain BCWR supplies and include Statement of Claim 36-65554, with appropriate conditions.
