Watson Lake Water Enhancement

FEBRUARY 7, 2023

Watson Lake Reservoir has been listed as impaired for nitrogen, phosphorus, and dissolved oxygen. In response to the Total Daily Maximum Limits (TMDLs), the City developed and implemented a TMDL Action Plan. The objectives of these plans are to provide activities and actions that the City can take to achieve compliance over time with the TMDLs.

This project generally consists of stocking the lake with herbivorous fish (White Amur) an environmentally sound management technique for weed removal, construction of fish barriers, installation of an aeration system, and an on-going maintenance plan.

WSP, formerly known as Wood Environmental, has submitted a scope and fee proposal for the first phase of engineering services to provide plans and specifications for an aeration system. Stocking of herbivorous fish will likely come in a subsequent phase. The engineering contract was awarded to WSP on January 24, 2023.
